Website: Any members who would like to participate in Wednesday Night Golf must be registered on the WNG website at www.wednightgolf.com. No action is required for any members who have previously registered on the site. If there are any members who would like to join Wednesday Night Golf, new participants can register on the site using the Registration Code "**wng2024**". The website will continue to be the go-to for Wednesday Night Golf updates, the season scoring leaderboard, and the roster of teams.

Weekly Scoring: Weekly matches can be played as either 18 holes (consisting of three 6-hole "mini-matches" and one 18-hole team match) or 9 holes (consisting of three 3-hole "mini-matches" and one 9 hole match), between two teams of two individuals each. Each match is scored based on net scores, using USGA handicapping.

- The two low-handicappers from each team play three mini-matches, for 1 point each (3 total points).
- The two high-handicappers from each team play three mini-matches, for 1 point each (3 total points).
- Each team of two plays a best-ball format match, for 6 points. In this format, each team's lowest net score applies in scoring each hole of the match.
- A 2-point bonus also applies when a team plays a team for the first time each season. This is intended to encourage playing a different team each week during the season.

Each format above is played as match play. The individual or team winning each match is awarded the points allotted above. If a match is tied, each team splits the allotted points.

Season Competition: Each team will be responsible for scheduling matches and posting scores to the website weekly. Scores must be posted on the website by Friday at noon to receive points for that week. Matches must be played based on the schedule above to be eligible to be posted for the season-long competition and all matches must be played on Wednesday (there is no rescheduling matches to other dates). In the event weather does not permit Wednesday Night Golf play, a communication will be sent and there will be no official Wednesday Night Golf matches that can be scored to the website on that day.

Each team's points are aggregated throughout the course of the season, with each team's lowest two scores being "dropped" from the season total. The top teams will be awarded prizes at the end of the season.

Billing: Each participant in Wednesday Night Golf will be charged an annual fee. Any member registered as a substitute will only be charged the annual fee if the individual attends the season ending banquet.

Season Ending Banquet: The season-ending banquet is scheduled to be held on the last week of Wednesday Night Golf, August 28, 2024.
